Did you know that the "Indian Bible College" has been serving Native American tribes for decades? In obedience to the Great Commission, committed Christian visionaries saw the need to train and equip indigenous Navajo leaders of churches on the vast Navajo Reservation.

After all, Flagstaff is a border town next to over 200,000 Navajo people, the largest tribe in America, extending across Northern Arizona, Southern Colorado, Western New Mexico and Southern Utah.

So, this year on Saturday, July 16th, FaithWorks sponsored and led a one-day mission trip, enlisting 17 people from 6 different churches, to descend on the little-known east Flagstaff campus to provide much-needed building fix-up, painting and cleaning. It served as a great boost to the morale and maintenance of this unique, now multi-tribe Christian ministry. We were also able to leave behind a \$450 cash gift to assist one of the staff families.
